What is it?

A convivial event where participants exchange recommendations about the books they are reading or have read. Such recommendations can extend to films and even to better quality television programmes.

The books and films can be fiction or non-fiction/documentary. Although they do not need to be overtly conservative in character, they should display some political, historical or social theme.

What is the format of the event?

Each participant can present their recommended work for up to five minutes. This is the maximum duration, in order to ensure that everyone gets the chance to speak.

There will of course be additional time for collective discussion among the participants. The normal language of conversation will be English.

To whom is the event open?

All members of British Conservatives in Paris are very welcome to attend.

They are also welcome to bring along non-members. There is no participation charge.

Where?
